During his 11-year career, WR Derrick Mason has become one of the most prolific targets in the NFL. In 2007, Mason led Baltimore in catches in 13 of 16 games. He posted the NFL's 4th most receptions (103), totaling a team-best 1,087 yards and 5 TDs. Mason also had a league-high 36 catches on 3rd down, 24 of which earned 1st downs.

Baltimore held the Bengals' high-powered offense to only 236 yards, including 50 in the 2nd half, and 3-of-13 on 3rd-down conversions. But 6 TOs and injuries to key players were too much to overcome in a 27-20 loss. Three TOs came in the 1st quarter, with 2 fumbles from QB Steve McNair and 1 from FB Le'Ron McClain leading to a 9-0 1st-quarter Bengals lead. McNair answered with an 8-play, 88-yard scoring drive capped by RB Musa Smith's 6-yard run. Smith and RB Willis McGahee combined to average 4.5 yards per carry for the game. Bengals LB Landon Johnson recovered a 3rd McNair fumble and returned it 34 yards for a TD. Baltimore briefly held the lead, 20-19, when S Ed Reed, who subbed for RS B.J. Sams (knee), took a punt 63 yards for a 4th-quarter TD. McNair then tossed an INT to DE Robert Geathers, whose 30-yard return set up the deciding 7-yard TD pass to WR T.J. Houshmandzadeh. RB Rudi Johnson added a 2-point conversion, to make the score 27-20. McNair, suffering from a 1st-quarter injury (groin), was replaced by QB Kyle Boller, who then converted a crucial 4th down with a 14-yard strike to WR Derrick Mason to tie the Bengals' 3. Boller soon hit TE Todd Heap for a tying TD from the 1-yard line, but the score was waived because of a protested pass interference call on Heap. T Jonathan Ogden (toe) and TE Daniel Wilcox (ankle) were also injured in the game.

A QB Kyle Boller-led offense posted a 17-point lead heading into the 4th quarter (20-3), but 2nd-year QB Kellen Clemens rallied a late-game Jets' comeback in the final minutes. In the end, Baltimore won a hard-fought 20-13 victory. Clemens rolled up 176 passing yards in the final period before LB Ray Lewis snared an INT with 1:04 remaining to clinch the win. He hit 8 different receivers, most notably Derrick Mason (8 catches for 54 yards) and Todd Heap (7 receptions for 76 yards). On the Ravens' 1st scoring drive, Boller went 6-for-6 for 53 yards, hitting RB Willis McGahee for a 2-yard TD. It was the 1st receiving TD of McGahee's career. Less than 10 seconds before the 1st half ended, Boller rushed for 2 key 1st downs and then lobbed a pass to Heap in the end zone for a 17-3 halftime lead. K Matt Stover produced 28- and 43-yard FGs, which Jets K Mike Nugent answered with 50- and 21-yard boots. The Ravens' pass rush suffered a blow when DT Trevor Pryce was lost due to a broken wrist in the 3rd quarter. Baltimore still posted 4 sacks. Pro Bowl Ravens on the sideline included McNair, Pryce and LT Jonathan Ogden, who missed the game with a toe injury.

Matt Stover's 46-yard FG as the game ended gave the Ravens a 26-23 victory. QB Steve McNair came in to lead a final scoring march. McNair posted a 106.7 QB rating, going 20-of-27 for 198 yards and a TD. Baltimore took the 20-3 halftime lead when Stover became the 5th-leading scorer in NFL history on his 2nd FG of the day, McNair found WR Derrick Mason for a 13-yard TD, and RS Yamon Figurs ran for a 75-yard PR to the end zone. When McNair lost a fumble in his own territory in the 3rd quarter, the Cardinals' K Neil Rackers connected on a 40-yard FG and Arizona then recovered an onside kick. But, CB Corey Ivy took the ball back when he stripped WR Larry Fitzgerald on the ensuing snap, and Stover then added a 43-yard FG, giving the Ravens what seemed to be a comfortable 23-6 lead. Boller relieved McNair (injured groin), while QB Matt Leinart's ineffectiveness led Arizona to sub QB Kurt Warner, whose no-huddle offense tied the score. Warner hit WR Anquan Boldin for 2 4th-quarter TDs, and Rackers evened the contest with 1:50 remaining when he hit a FG from 41 yards. Boller responded by going a perfect 5-of-5 for 32 yards on the last scoring drive. Stover's 4th FG of the day was good as time expired. It was the 13th game-winner of his 18-year career.

The Browns started off with 2 TDs on their opening possessions and maintained that lead in a 27-13 win over the Ravens at Cleveland Browns Stadium. After Cleveland's opening-drive score, McNair threw an INT to CB Leigh Bodden, and Browns QB Derek Anderson served a 78-yard bomb to WR Braylon Edwards on the next play. The Ravens shut down RB Jamal Lewis, who had one 28-yard gallop, but only totaled 64 yards on 23 carries (2.8 yards per rush). Sypniewski was in the game for an injured TE Todd Heap (hamstring) and TE Daniel Wilcox (foot), both of whom left in the 3rd quarter.

Three FGs from Matt Stover were all that it took for the Ravens to upend the San Francisco 49ers, 9-7. Baltimore's stifling defense held the Niners to only 163 yards of total offense. The Ravens were able to move the ball and hold QB Steve McNair sack-free thanks to a line of LT Jared Gaither, LG Jason Brown, C Chris Chester, RG Ben Grubbs and RT Marshal Yanda. This group featured 3 rookies, the 2nd-year Chester and 3rd-year Brown. Incumbent C Mike Flynn left in the 2nd quarter with a sprained right knee, while LT Adam Terry left the game earlier during the same drive with a sprained left ankle. Stover broke a scoreless tie with a 26-yard FG at the 2:44 mark on that series. After the defense forced a quick punt, McNair executed a perfect 2-minute drill that led to a 32-yard FG with 7 seconds remaining in the half. Stover added a 49-yard boot in the 3rd quarter that was set up by S Ed Reed's INT and 21-yard return. San Francisco QB Trent Dilfer pulled the 49ers to within 2 points (9-7) when he hit WR Bryan Gilmore on a 42-yard pass, and then followed that with a 23-yard TD strike to WR Arnaz Battle, 1 play later. In the 4th, K Joe Nedney's boot went wide from 52 yards. McNair then directed a clock-eating, game-ending drive to complete the victory.

Matt Stover booted 5 FGs, while the Ravens made life miserable for Rams QB Gus Frerotte, sacking him 4 times and nabbing a single-game franchise-record 5 INTs. DT Kelly Gregg also came up with a FR, making 6 TOs that were converted into 12 Baltimore points. The Ravens started 3 rookie offensive linemen and backup QB Kyle Boller. TE Todd Heap played for only 1 quarter (hamstring). The Ravens' defense limited St. Louis to 264 total yards, 83 in the 1st half, and a lone FG. Stover tied his own team record for most FGs in a single game, while RB Willis McGahee, who posted 61 yards on 25 carries, logged his 1st rushing TD as a Raven. After Stover's 1st FG late in the 1st quarter, DT Dwan Edwards posted his 1st-career INT when Frerotte bounced a pass off WR Drew Bennett's shoulder pads, which led to a 42-yard boot. McGahee's 2nd-quarter TD capped a 75-yard drive, aided by a 28-yard pass to WR Derrick Mason and a pass interference call that cost the Rams 27 yards. Another INT (CB Chris McAlister) came on the 2nd play after halftime, leading to another Stover FG. K Jeff Wilkins finally put the Rams on the scoreboard with a 32-yard FG, but was erased when DT Justin Bannan sacked Frerotte and forced a fumble. Gregg recovered it, leading to FG No. 4 for Stover. His 5th came after S Ed Reed's pick and subsequent 15-yard return.

The Ravens lost 3 fumbles in their own territory in the opening 15 minutes and gave up an INT in the middle of the 2nd quarter en route to a 38-7 drubbing on national TV. The turnovers led directly to 4 of QB Ben Roethlisberger's career-high 5 TD passes. Ravens QB Steve McNair had missed the previous 2 games (back), and on Baltimore's 1st series, a McNair fumble on the Ravens' 28-yard line set up a Steelers' TD. S Ed Reed fumbled on a PR, which led to another Roethlisberger TD pass. RB Willis M'Gahee was then stripped by S Troy Polamalu at the Ravens' 35, setting up a 30-yard TD strike to WR Nate Washington, 2 snaps into the 2nd quarter. Four minutes later, McNair again fumbled. It was recovered by M'Gahee, but the RB was tackled at the 3, and a 3-and-out led to the 3rd TD for "Big Ben." He got another chance to score after a McNair INT on the next possession, capping a 44-yard drive with a 7-yard strike to Washington - making it 35-0 at 1:51 in the 2nd quarter. The Ravens got on the board when M'Gahee sprinted 33 yards for a TD. The play was set up by Musa Smith's 52-yard KOR. Baltimore welcomed back C Mike Flynn (knee), LT Jonathan Ogden (toe) and RT Adam Terry (ankle) from injury, but were without Pro Bowlers TE Todd Heap (hamstring) and CBs Chris McAlister (knee) and Samari Rolle (illness). The Ravens set the franchise mark for fewest net yards gained (104) and tied the record for fewest 1st downs (5).

Despite a stellar defensive performance that kept the high-powered Bengals' offense out of the end zone, the Ravens turned the ball over 6 times and fell to their AFC North rivals. QB Steve McNair committed 3 turnovers, losing 2 fumbles and throwing an INT at the end of the 1st half. McNair had trouble generating any offense against a team that went into the contest giving up an average of 397.1 yards per game. The Bengals had not held any team to under 20 points all season, but the only Ravens points came on RB Willis McGahee's 1-yard TD run with 1:56 remaining. McNair finished 17-of-26 for 128 yards before being replaced by QB Kyle Boller midway through the 4th quarter. McNair's 3 turnovers were compounded by a McGahee fumble, a fumbled KOR by RS Cory Ross and a Boller INT. K Shayne Graham was able to convert 4 of the 5 2nd-half turnovers into FGs after posting 2 FGs in the 1st half. Baltimore's defense was without starting CBs Samari Rolle (illness) and Chris McAlister (knee) and backup David Pittman (head), then lost 3rd corner Corey Ivy in the 1st quarter (concussion). The unit still managed to keep QB Carson Palmer in check while limiting the Bengals to only 70 rushing yards. Palmer completed 23 of 34 attempts for 271 yards, including a 50-yarder to WR Chris Henry, but was held without a passing TD for the 1st time in 2007. The Ravens also tagged Palmer for 3 sacks and multiple hurries.

No one could have written a more bizarre ending to Baltimore's 33-30 OT loss to the Browns. K Matt Stover capped a gritty comeback by hitting a 47-yard FG with 26 seconds left in the game. The Ravens thought they won, 30-27, when K Phil Dawson's 51-yard kick as time expired was ruled "no good." The ball bounced off the curved support post and fell forward into the end zone, prompting officials to convene for nearly 5 minutes before they reversed the call. Many Ravens had to be brought back out of the locker room. Cleveland won the coin toss in OT and needed just 1 possession before Dawson's 33-yard game-winner. Baltimore overcame 3 turnovers in the opening quarter to head into halftime trailing 13-7. The Browns got 2 1st-half Dawson FGs and a 1-yard TD run from RB Jamal Lewis, while LB Ray Lewis took an INT 35 yards for the Ravens' 1st score. QB Kyle Boller, starting for an injured QB Steve McNair (shoulder), began the 2nd half by going 3-of-3 for 44 yards, and RB Willis McGahee capped the 8-play drive with a 2-yard TD. Cleveland QB Derek Anderson answered with a 1-yard TD sneak and a Boller INT was returned 100 yards by Browns FS Brodney Pool for a TD. Boller shook off the pick to lead 2 4th-quarter FG drives and tied the game at 27 by finding WR Devard Darling for a 27-yard TD. Baltimore's defense held the Browns to a 3-and-out, getting the ball back for a 49-yard drive to set up Stover's last FG. Boller became the Ravens' all-time passing yards leader in the game.

In addition, G/T Marshal Yanda started at RT for Adam Terry (ankle). The Ravens jumped out to a 7-3 lead in the 2nd quarter on RB Willis McGahee's 1-yard TD run, but San Diego responded with 26 unanswered points fueled by QB Philip Rivers, who passed for 249 yards and 3 TDs. In the 1st half, the Ravens gave up 2 fumbles that led to K Nate Kaeding FGs, while TE Antonio Gates broke away for 35- and 25-yard TD catches. Gates finished with 6 catches for 105 yards. The Ravens did a lot of things right in trying to beat the undefeated New England Patriots, but ended on the wrong side of a 27-24 score. A last-minute TD pass from QB Tom Brady to WR Jabar Gaffney beat the home team. After Gaffney secured the 8-yard reception with 44 seconds remaining, the Ravens weren't finished. QB Kyle Boller's 52-yard heave was caught by WR Mark Clayton at New England's 3 as time expired. Baltimore controlled the ball behind RB Willis McGahee's 138 yards, and sacked Brady 3 times, holding him to a 76.3 QB rating (season low). The Ravens lost their 6th straight, but held a 376-326 net yards advantage while limiting the Patriots to a season-low 3rd-down efficiency (2-of-12, 17%). Baltimore's defense kept the Patriots out of the end zone, forcing a FG on the game's opening drive. Boller's 53-yard pass to WR Devard Darling set up a 4-yard TD toss to WR Derrick Mason for a 7-3 lead. K Matt Stover added a FG, but the Patriots knotted the score at 10 before the half. McGahee carried the ball 6 times on an 8-play drive out of the break, capped with a gritty 17-yard TD run, his 7th-straight game with a rushing TD. The teams then traded TDs, including a 1-yard Boller dart to TE Daniel Wilcox, while a FG from K Stephen Gostkowski closed the margin to 4 points in the 4th quarter. The Patriots converted 2 4th downs on the final series, and a debated defensive holding call on DB Jamaine Winborne led to Brady's game-winning TD pass, which was reviewed by the instant replay official.

QB Peyton Manning threw 4 TD passes, and the Indianapolis Colts built a 30-point lead by the 2nd quarter while picking on a makeshift Baltimore secondary. The Ravens, without starting CBs Chris McAlister (knee) and Samari Rolle (shoulder), had 5 turnovers, including 4 from QB Kyle Boller. Manning found WR Reggie Wayne for a 34-yard TD after marching 65 yards in 9 plays to open the game. RB Willis McGahee fumbled on his 2nd carry, which CB Marlin Jackson returned 21 yards to set up RB Joseph Addai's 1-yard TD run. Boller gave up the 1st of his 3 INTs on the next possession, leading to Manning's 19-yard lob to Addai for a score. When Baltimore was then forced into a 3-and-out, Colts DB Michael Coe deflected a Sam Koch punt for a safety. Addai added another 11-yard scoring run before rookie WR Yamon Figurs took a KO 94 yards to paydirt in the 2nd quarter. Manning answered with a 57-yard bomb to WR Anthony Gonzalez that made the score 37-7. Boller fumbled the 3rd snap after the half, which Manning then turned into a 40-yard TD toss to Gonzalez. After completing 13 of 17 for 249 yards and 4 scores, Manning was pulled from action. Boller capped a 13-play, 63-yard scoring drive with a 4-yard dart to WR Devard Darling before taking a seat in the 4th quarter. In his pro debut, QB Troy Smith added a 6-yard TD run. During the contest, WR Derrick Mason's 3 catches (30 yards) made him the Ravens' all-time single-season receptions leader.

Stalwart K Matt Stover missed a game-winning 44-yard FG in the extra period, giving Miami WR Greg Camarillo the opportunity to turn a short reception into a 64-yard TD 3 plays later. The Ravens took a 13-3 2nd quarter lead on 2 Stover FGs and QB Kyle Boller's 17-yard TD to WR Derrick Mason. The Dolphins, who won their 1st game of the season, then gained momentum when DE Jason Taylor blocked a 50-yard FG attempt with :01 left in the half. Miami posted 13 straight points after the break, taking the lead with 1:56 remaining on K Jay Feely's 29-yard FG. When the ensuing KO went out of bounds, rookie QB Troy Smith, subbing for Boller (concussion), engineered an 11-play, 59-yard drive highlighted by 13- and 15-yard connections to WR Mark Clayton, and an 8-yard pass to TE Quinn Sypniewski. Faced with 3rd-and-10 from Miami's 10-yard line, Smith found WR Devard Darling at the 1, and Stover's 18-yard boot with 0:12 remaining sent the game to OT. Baltimore won the coin toss and relied on the ground attack to move the chains, rushing on 8 of 9 plays before Stover's attempt sailed wide left. RB Willis McGahee finished with 104 yards on 29 carries, topping the century mark for the 5th time as a Raven. Baltimore played without starting CBs, Chris McAlister (IR, knee) and Samari Rolle (shoulder), and LB Ray Lewis was lost in the 3rd quarter with a dislocated finger.

The Ravens limped into Qwest Field on their 3rd West Coast trip of the season to fall 27-6 to the NFC West-champion Seattle Seahawks, extending a franchise-record 9-game losing streak. Baltimore started 4 rookies on offense - including QB Troy Smith - and missed the services of 6 injured Pro Bowlers in the defeat. Seattle QB Matt Hasselbeck threw 2 TD passes to offset 2 INTs as the Seahawks built a 27-0 lead before Smith found WR Derrick Mason with a 79-yard TD bomb in the 4th quarter. The play was not only Smith's 1st TD pass, it was also the longest catch of Mason's 11-year career. Hasselbeck faced an injury-depleted Ravens defense. Neither team could get anything started in the 1st quarter, as a series of punts was only interrupted by S Ed Reed's 7th INT on the season. Hasselbeck threw his 1st TD pass, 21 yards to WR Nate Burleson, at 11:34 in the 2nd when he got free behind rookie CB Willie Gaston. LB Leroy Hill then returned a RB Mike Anderson fumble 20 yards for a score, which was followed by RB Shaun Alexander's 14-yard TD reception. Anderson's turnover snuffed out a Baltimore possession that began with CB Derrick Martin's INT on the 2-yard line. RB Willis McGahee left the game after 5 carries with cracked ribs, leaving the offense on Smith's shoulders. It took 7 drives for Smith to march into Seattle territory, but that was derailed when DE Patrick Kerney sacked the QB, causing another fumble.

After enduring 9 straight losses, the Ravens closed the 2007 campaign with a 27-21 win over the Steelers. RBs Musa Smith and Cory Ross helped the Ravens build a 20-point lead, but it took a last-minute INT from CB David Pittman, who secured Charlie Batch's 50-yard attempt to WR Santonio Holmes, to win the game. Batch tossed 2 4th-quarter TD passes, while Baltimore rookie QB Troy Smith made his 2nd-career start. M. Smith, who was the 3rd RB on the depth chart a week before the game, got the start for RBs Willis McGahee (ribs) and Mike Anderson (hamstring), who were both injured the week before. Pittsburgh fumbled the opening kickoff, leading to M. Smith's 2-yard TD run. K Matt Stover added a 28-yard FG on the next Ravens possession. By the time Ross weaved his way through the defense in the 2nd quarter, the Ravens had a 17-0 cushion. RB Najeh Davenport ran for a 1-yard TD 3 minutes later, in a drive that was aided by a 47-yard pass interference on CB Corey Ivy. T. Smith found WR DevarD Darling for a TD in the 3rd quarter for a 20-point lead. The Steelers rallied when Batch found Holmes for a 59-yard TD. Pittsburgh recovered the ensuing onside kick, and Batch mounted another 56-yard TD drive. P Sam Koch's punt on the next series backed the Steelers up to their 11, and Pittman corralled Batch's late throw to Holmes for his 2nd INT of the game. LB Nick Greisen, starting for injured LB Ray Lewis (hand), led the team with 15 tackles.

2007 RAVENS PLAYER HIGHLIGHTS

Below is a list of Ravens player highlights from the 2007 season:

WR Derrick Mason

Mason set a career high and Ravens franchise record with 103 receptions, breaking his own 2005 record of 86 catches. Entering 2008, he is also 2nd (Todd Heap, 3,897) on the Ravens' all-time receptions list with 2,910.

K Matt Stover

With 1,822 career points, Stover moved into 4th on the NFL's all-time scoring list. With his 107 points, Stover hit the 100 mark for the 5th straight season and 11th time in his 18-year career.

RS Yamon Figurs

A rookie in 2007, Figurs finished with 1,138 KOR yards, 2nd in team history to B.J. Sams (1,251 in 2004). Figurs also became the 1st Raven to return both a punt and a kickoff for a TD in the same season.

QB Kyle Boller

Boller became the Ravens' all-time leading passer

in yards (7,846), attempts (1,311) and completions (746), moving past Vinny Testaverde into the team's top spot.

DT Kelly Gregg

Gregg set a career high with 111 tackles (78 solo), becoming the 2nd-leading tackler in Ravens history. Entering 2008, Gregg has 616 career stops, behind LB Ray Lewis (2,022).

DT Haloti Ngata

The 2nd-year Ngata tallied career highs in tackles (94) and sacks (3) in his breakout campaign.

RB Willis M^cGahee

M^cGahee scored a rushing TD in 7 consecutive games, setting a franchise record.

OLB Terrell Suggs

Suggs hit the 45-sack milestone, which stands 3rd most in team history. He also posted a career-high 95 total tackles in 2007.
